

Setup

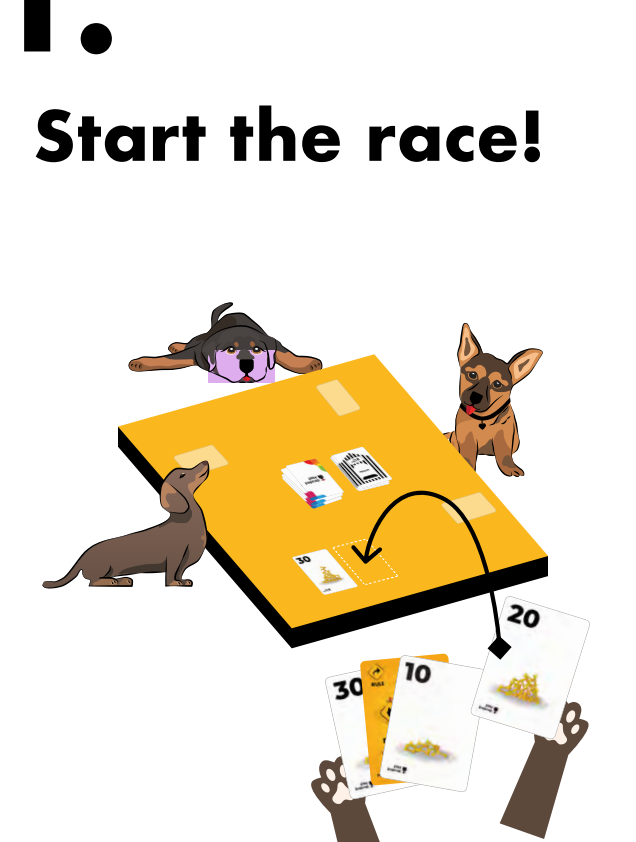
Each game has a total of 100 cards.



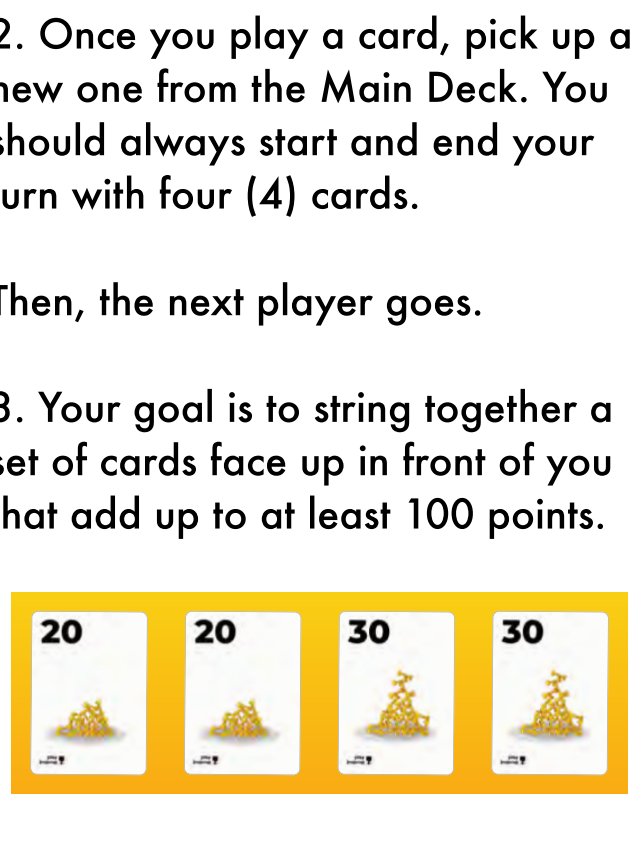
Shuffle each deck



Then, place the Penalty Deck in the center of the table.



Deal four main cards to each player



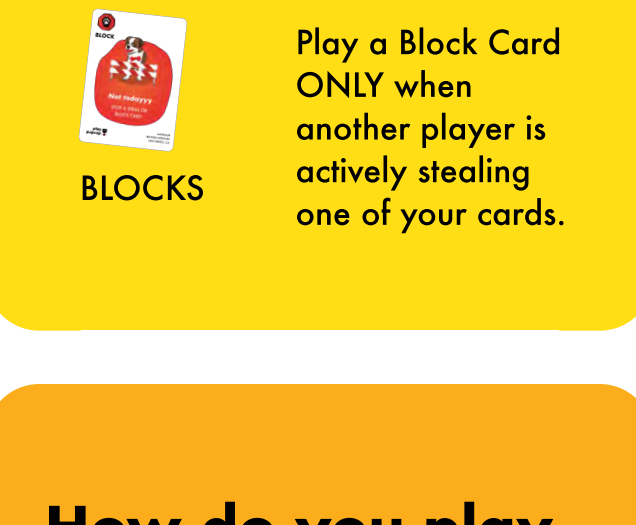
Then, place the remaining main cards face down in the center of the table.

HOW TO PLAY

1. Start the race!



1. Take turns playing **ONE** point card (10, 20, or 30 points) and lay it face up in front of you. This is your score.



2. Once you play a card, pick up a new one from the Main Deck. You should always start and end your turn with four (4) cards.

Then, the next player goes.

3. Your goal is to string together a set of cards face up in front of you that add up to at least 100 points.



2. The first player to at least 100 points WINS!

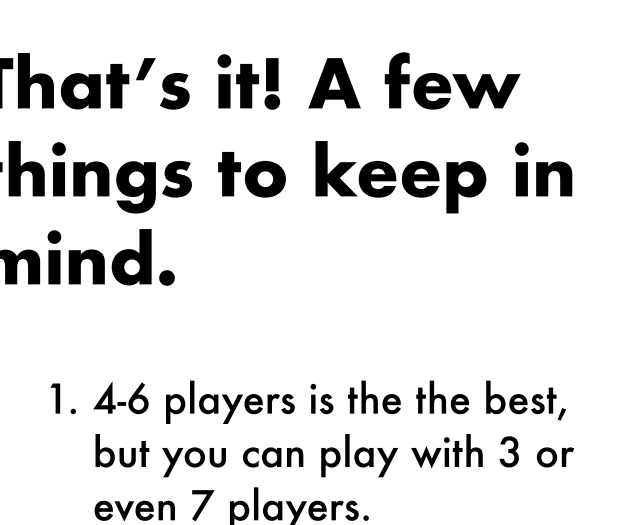
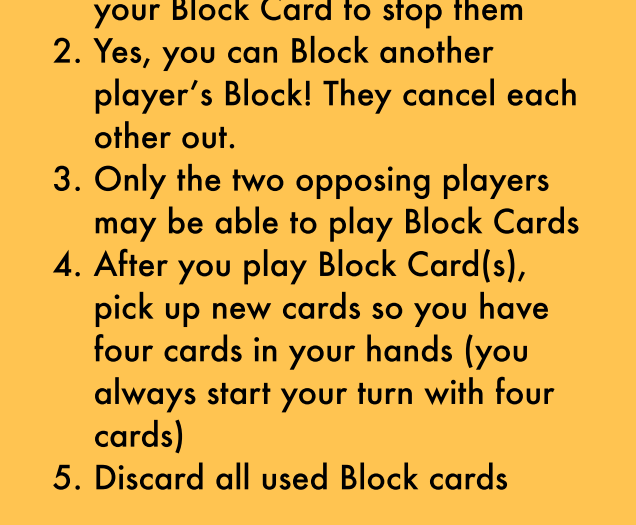


3. WINNER TWERKS THEIR TAIL OFF

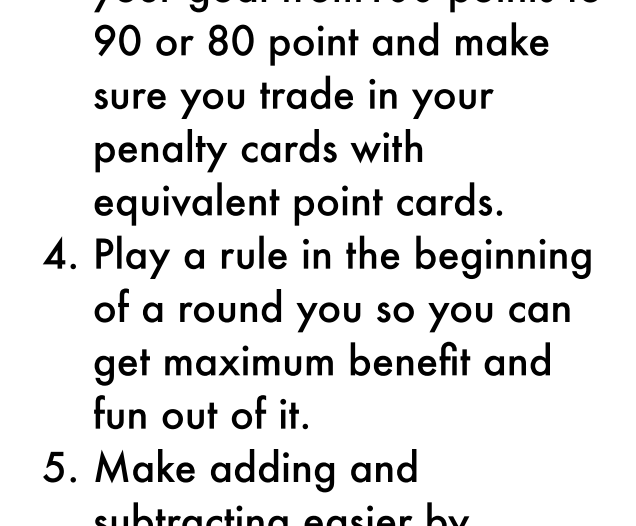
On my turn, can I play a different card instead of a point card?

Yes!

There are 4 types of cards you may have in your hands: Points, Rules, Steals, and Blocks. On your turn, you can play either a Point, Rule, or Steal card.



When do I play block cards?



Play a Block Card **ONLY** when another player is actively stealing one of your cards.

How do you play a Rule Card?

On your turn, instead of playing a Point Card, you could play a Rule Card. Rule Cards:

To play a Rule:

1. Read out loud your Rule card then place it face up in front of you (next to your other cards)
2. Your rule is now in effect
3. Trick or tease other players into breaking your rule (or other players' rules!)
4. If any player gets caught breaking a rule, then they must draw a Penalty Card.

Penalty cards have negative values and deduct from your total points. Place Penalty Cards next to your face up Cards.

How do you play a Steal Card?

On your turn, instead of playing a Point Card or Rule Card, you could play a Steal Card. Steal Cards:

To play a Steal Card:

1. Show your steal card and take any card that is face up on the table
2. **UNLESS**, that player plays a Block card which stops you from stealing their card (see more below)
3. If you successfully steal another player's card, then place your new card face up next to your cards
4. Discard all used Steals in a discard pile (**PRO TIP:** Flip over the top of the box and put your discarded cards inside)
